

## Agricom 2020 Waimumu Colouring in Competition

### How to Enter

1. All entries must be received at the Gore PGG Wrightson store by 5pm Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2020.
2. To enter and be eligible for the prize draw, entrants must submit their entry by handing the colouring in sheet to an Agricom Representative at the Waimumu field days or to a PGG Wrightson Representative at the Gore PGG Wrightson store (46 Medway Street, East Gore, Gore 9710)
3. The competition runs between Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February and Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2020.
4. No responsibility is accepted by Agricom for ineligible, lost or fraudulent entries. Ineligible entries include, but are not limited to, entries received after 5pm Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2020 or entries that do not fit the criteria of the entry including if the entrant is younger than 5 and older than 12 years old as of the first day of the 2020 Waimumu field days (Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2020).
5. One entry per entrant in the competition.
